Congregational Meeting to Elect Elders/Deacons December 10, 2017 after worship Dear Ones of Vashon,

If you've been in my office or in the Chapel during morning prayer or liturgy group, you probably have surmised that I love candles. For a very long time, the single solitary flame of a candle calls my own spirit into a calm sense of wonder. Anne Frank wrote in her diary that "a candle both defines and defies darkness." It is the first thing I do when I get to my office, before I hang up my coat or turn on the heat, I light the candle on my desk.

We light candles every Sunday in worship, we keep a special one lit for the victims of gun violence in our nation. We light candles on birthdays and at weddings, we light them for romance, we light them for centering, we light them to remember others or to lift our prayers.

We light candles, I suspect, because we are drawn towards the light.

As we proceed through this month together, we will light candles that we name, Hope, Love, Peace, Joy and on Christmas Eve, we will light the Christ candle. And then, we will light candle after candle, sharing light with one another and hold them up on that silent night. Thomas Jefferson said, "A candle loses nothing when it lights another candle." The imagery that Jefferson captures in that statement is one I hope will help guide us through this Advent and Christmas season. As we share hope, love, peace, joy and Christ with one another and the world around us, we lose nothing, we only gain...and we move one lit candle closer to the Realm of God.

I treasure the light within each of you, I treasure seeing the glimpses of your goodness and grace. Those moments are touch points with the Holy for me, lit candles that defy the darkness that fills our evening news and so much of what we carry in our own hearts. My prayer for you this Advent season is that you will continue to light candles, both literally and with your lives. My prayer is that we surrender to the quiet of the solitary flame that is God Incarnate and so let it fill us again that we take it out to a world in desperate need.

#### **Memorial Committee Report**

#### Clerk's Corner

Session held its monthly business meeting on November 8 with all members attending. Session reviewed the membership roll, as it is required to do annually, and removed one member. Other members will be contacted as to their membership intentions. Session discussed and approved a proposal to create a congregational care team, composed of people who wish to be of service to those in need, but who do not want to be (or are not eligible to be) a deacon. After discussion, Jacq Skeffington was elected as a Second Alternate Commissioner to the 2018 PCUSA General Assembly. Brownie explained the offer of a piano and the need for tuning and maintenance of the organ; session agreed to accept the piano. Session also set two dates for December: reception of new members on December 17 and a congregational meeting to elect elders and deacons on December 10. After brief discussion, session voted that the Christmas Eve offering will be donated to Presbyterian Disaster Agency for Puerto Rico hurricane relief. Jacq reported on the progress of the Nominating Committee seeking elders and deacons, and summarized proceedings of the October Presbytery meeting. Finally, session informally discussed the pastor's terms of call, which will be set at the January congregational meeting.

Session also held a special meeting on November 19 to consider an offer from OMAX Corporation to buy back 1,500 shares of stock at \$7.80 per share. Session approved the sale and voted to use the proceeds to reduce the mortgage.

## Longest Night Advent Spiral Service Wednesday, December 20 at 7:00 p.m.

Vashon United Methodist Church Fellowship Hall

Please join us for an Advent Spiral Service on the eve of the shortest day of the year. This season of lengthening night and gathering against the cold is often difficult for those who grieve a loss, whether it is the loss of loved ones, the loss of opportunities, or the loss of health and vitality. In such times we gather for comfort and prayer, encouragement and hope.

For this time of meditation, a spiral of evergreen boughs is arranged on the floor and golden stars are scattered along the spiral. After shared readings and prayers, contemplative music is played while each person in turn walks the spiral to its center and finds the Christ Candle, symbolizing the journey inward to encounter the light of Christ. Each person then lights a candle from the Christ Candle and walks back out, placing the light on the path to light the way for others. This simple act reminds us that we carry the light within us as a sign of love for the world: kindled by God through Christ. The Spiral Service is appropriate for all ages.
